| Class 1 | Junior 70cm* SJ | 0 and 0 BE Foundation Points. 0 and 0 BS Club Points gained at 90cm or higher. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. Horses cannot have competed at 80 or higher in the same competition year. BS Club points gained at 70cm and 80cm will not be counted |
| Class 2 | Senior 70cm* SJ | |
| Class 3 | Junior 80cm* SJ | 1 BE point. 0 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. Horses cannot have competed at 90 or higher in the same competition year. All horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 competition in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. |
| Class 4 Section A & B | Senior 80cm* SJ (A) & L&SE Qualifier (B) | |
| Class 5 | Junior 90cm* SJ | 20 BE Points. 500 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. |
| Class 6 | Senior 90cm* SJ | |
| Class 7 | Jnr/Snr 100cm* SJ | Mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior. 60 BE Points. 999 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. |
| Class 8 | Jnr/Snr 110cm* SJ | This is a mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior No limit BE/BS Points. |
| Class 9 | Junior Style Jumping | 75cm: 0 BE Points. 0 BS Points other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, FBHS, BHSI and BHSII (Qualification not to have been gained within the past ten years) are not permitted. May be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. 85cm: 10 BE Points. 225 BS Points. Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years are not permitted. |

Prelim Entries: All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £29 per team or £9 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (Sunday 25th June). Prelim entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries (www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads), or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop (www.britishhorse.com/sections/riding-club-entries.html).

Withdrawals/Team Changes:

Must be made by email to the Entries Secretary before Thursday 13th July except in exceptional circumstances. Changes after 1700 hrs on Thursday 13th July must be made at the competition before the appropriate class starts.

Equine Influenza Certificate:

All BRC competitors must have an up-to-date Equine Influenza Certificate which must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to a qualifying competition. The competitor is responsible for producing the Certificate when collecting their number.

A photocopy must be sent to the Entries Secretary with the Official Entry Form. Photocopies need not be sent for any horse confirmed as listed on the Area 10 Database 2017.

Horse-box Sign:

Please clearly display on an A4 sign inside the windscreen of your vehicle your Club, your own name and contact number (plus emergency contact number for the day). This will facilitate us contacting you in an emergency.

Club Helpers:

It shall be a condition of entry that all Clubs entering shall supply the names; email address, telephone numbers and previous experience of one HALF DAY helper per team or one per two individual entries. These volunteers must be advised by their clubs of their duties assigned by the by the Organiser in the week prior to the competition.

A form can be downloadable from the Area 10 website (www.brcarea10.org.uk). This form must be enclosed with the Area Qualifier Entry Form. **If Club volunteers do not fulfil their prescribed duties, their Club's riders will not be allowed to continue in the competition.**

Hat Tagging:

All hats must be tagged before competitors may ride. Hats may be tagged at the competition in the Secretary's Area. See BRC Rules Appendix 4.

*Only relevant for half day helpers. There is no guarantee that the preferred time will be given, but will be accommodated where possible.

Each club must provide the required number of helpers for either a half or full day as stated in the schedule. More than one person may be used to cover a helper's slot. This is down to the club to arrange, NOT the organiser. E.g. if a helper is required for a full day then a club may provide 3 people to cover this period. However this is still counted as 1 helper. See schedule for details of number helpers required per team

Club Helpers: It shall be a condition of entry that all Clubs entering supply the names, email address, telephone numbers and relevant experience of the required numbers of helpers who would be willing to help the organising team, for example jump judging, tack checking, stewarding, flu vaccination checks, tea runs etc. These volunteers must be told in advance by their clubs that they will be expected to **help all day** and will be informed of their duties by the event organiser, in the week prior to the competition. This form must be enclosed with the Area Entry. If Club volunteers do not fulfil their duties that Club's riders will be eliminated and not be allowed to continue in the competition.
