Completed Declaration Forms, Flu Cert & Hats (for tagging/checking) must be taken to the secretary when collecting numbers. Please make sure all your competitors have a copy of the schedule and are aware of the eligibility rules.

The BRC Fibre-Beet Festival of the Horse Championship is to be held on
30-31 May 2020 at Washbrook Farm, Aston-le-Walls, Northamptonshire.

Rules

- 1 This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook 2020 and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook> In the event of cancellation of this event £5 shall be retained per competitor.
- 2 All entries are accepted only upon the terms of the general rules and conditions below.
- 3 The Judge's decision is final.
- 4 **Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook 2020. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518. The passport must accompany the horse on the day of the competition. It is the responsibility of the clubs to ensure these are correct. An incorrect passport will result in disqualification.**
- 5 Health and Safety – The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards,
- 6 Disclaimer of Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way what so ever.
- 7 All hats must have a visible **aqua** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current handbook.
- 8 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times while on the show ground.
- 9 Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees. Cheques should be made payable to Faversham & District Riding Club. Clubs should send a single Riding Club cheque.
- 10 Only riders and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities at FSC.
- 11 **Competitors are requested not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park.**
- 12 **Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers & left unattended.**
- 13 All ridden horses/ponies must be 4yrs or over.
- 14 Protests – These may be lodged only by the Chairman or Chef d'Equipe or nominated representative of the club concerned. These must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be addressed to the organiser of the competition.
- 15 All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.

BRC Rosettes to be awarded: 1st to 6th

The highest placed individuals not part of the winning qualifying team from each arena will also qualify to compete at the National Championships (Senior & Junior)

(c) Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, For Eventing restrictions at CT75, CT85, HT80, CH80, HT 90 & CH90 APPLIES TO 2* and above only and for HT100 & CH100 Applies to 3* & above only. No restrictions on 100+.

(d) Other than notional points gained in 70cm & 80cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted.

(e) All points gained for double clears will be counted. SJI points should be converted into pounds by multiplying by 9 for horses that have gained winnings in 120cm classes or above, 3 for horses that have gained winnings in classes lower than 120cm & 2.5 for ponies.

(f) Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have competed at BE 100 or above in the current or previous year.

All entrants must pay a pre-entry of £40 per team or £12 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (by the 21st March 2020). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the prelim website <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/login?referral=%2Fselect>. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces (payable to BRC HQ). Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

Area Entries to be sent to the Show Secretary on the BRC FOTH Entry Forms (see BRC Website) by the 31st March 2020. **Please include a copy of the Flu Vacc Identification & Record for all horses not on the Area Database. Also include helpers form, providing one helper per team as well as one helper per two individuals entered please, able to help for the morning or afternoon. Helpers contact details, including mobile phone number & email to be provided with the Area entry form. Failure to provide required helpers (including on the day) will result in Elimination.**

Area Entry - Fee £95 per team and £25 for Individuals

All cheques should be made payable to 'Faversham & District Riding Club' and have the name of the team and Club printed clearly on the reverse side. One cheque per club please. A charge of £10 will be made for any dishonoured cheques
